

DOCUMENTS CONFIRMING LANGUAGE FLUENCY

1. Documents confirming fluency in Polish:

- a) a certificate of completion of a one-year preparatory course for education through the medium of Polish at institutions designated by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education or the Polish National Agency for Academic Exchange;
- b) a certificate of fluency in Polish at B1 level or higher, issued by the State Commission for the Certification of Proficiency in Polish as a Foreign Language;
- c) a diploma or other document confirming the completion of higher education conducted in Polish, or studies in Polish Philology;
- d) a pass in the Polish language examination*, overseen by a committee appointed by the Dean of the UG's Faculty of Languages or the Director of the UG's Academic Centre of Polish Language and Culture for Foreigners;
- e) a certificate of completion of a secondary school education, obtained in the Polish system;
- f) a certificate of the award of the title of winner/finalist of the central level of the Polish Literature and Language School Olympiad Contest.

2. Documents confirming fluency in English:

- a) the International Baccalaureate Diploma or the European Baccalaureate Diploma;
- b) International English Language Testing System (IELTS) certificate with an average score of 5.5 or higher;
- c) Test of English for International Communication (TOEIC) Listening & Reading certificate with an overall score of 785 points or higher;
- d) Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL IBT) certificate with an overall score of 87 points or higher;
- e) Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) certificate with a minimum of 510 points in the Paper-Based Test (PBT), supplemented with a minimum of 3.5 points in the Test of Written English (TWE);
- f) Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) certificate with a minimum of 180 points in the Computer-Based Test (CBT), supplemented with a minimum of 50 points in the Test of Spoken English (TSE);
- g) University of Cambridge ESOL Examinations:
 - B2 First (previous name: Cambridge First Certificate in English (FCE)),

- C1 Advanced (previous name: Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English (CAE)),
- C2 Proficiency (previous name: Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE));
- h) Pearson Test of English (PTE Academic) certificate with an overall score of 59 or higher;
- a certificate of secondary education/a diploma of higher education, a diploma supplement/transcript/grade report with a note confirming that English was the language of instruction;
- j) a university diploma in English Philology;
- k) a diploma confirming the completion of secondary school/university studies in the USA, UK, Ireland, Australia, New Zealand or Canada;
- l) a certificate issued by a secondary school or a university confirming that English was the only language of instruction;
- m) a pass in the English language examination*, overseen by a committee appointed by the Director of the Foreign Languages Centre.

Note:

* participation in the examination is conditional upon the payment of the application fee of 85 PLN.
