Ordinance No. 17/ R/20 of the Rector of the University of Gdańsk of 3 March 2020

on a ban on trips to selected countries for employees, students and doctoral students of the University of Gdańsk

Under article 23 section 1 of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 85), with regard to the recommendations of the Chief Sanitary Inspector regarding the public health emergency of international concern related to the outbreak of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) outbreak, the recommendations of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the recommendations of the Minister of Science and Higher Education - the following principles are adopted:

§1.

All trips by the employees, students and doctoral students at the University of Gdańsk to the countries with the COVID-19 outbreak and the arrivals of foreigners from those countries are suspended until further notice.

§2.

The current list of countries vulnerable to the COVID-19 outbreak and subject to the suspension of trips and arrivals will be published on the website of the University of Gdańsk.

§ 3.

- 1. Employees, students and doctoral students who have recently stayed in the countries referred to in § 2 are recommended to remain in their place of residence for a period of 14 days from the date of return and to follow the recommendations of the Chief Sanitary Inspector.
- 2. The respective dean, head of a general university unit, head of a doctoral school or direct superior must be promptly informed of the return from the countries referred to in § 2.
- 3. In the case of students and doctoral students who document their return from the countries referred to in § 2, the absence from classes during the period referred to in paragraph 1 will be justified.
- 4. In the case of employees, the decision to justify the absence is made by the dean or head of a general university unit.

§4.

This Ordinance shall enter into force on the day of signature.
